Adultery/Pornography - You have heard that it was said, 'YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY'; but I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart. Matthew 5:27-28

Anger - He who is slow to anger has great understanding, but he who is quick-tempered exalts folly. A tranquil heart is life to the body.... **Proverbs 14:29-30**

Anger - A hot-tempered man stirs up strife, but the slow to anger calms a dispute. Proverbs 15:18

Anxiety - Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. *Philippians 4:6-7*

Bitterness - Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you. **Ephesians 4:31-32**

Covetousness - For this you know with certainty, that no immoral or impure person or covetous man, who is an idolater, has an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God. **Ephesians 5:5**

Depression - I waited patiently for Yahweh; and He inclined to me and heard my cry. He brought me up out of the pit of destruction, out of the miry clay, and He set my feet upon a rock making my footsteps firm. He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God.... **Psalm 40:1-3**

Drunkenness - And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, but be filled with the Spirit, speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord; **Ephesians 5:18-19**

Envy - Therefore, putting aside all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander, 1 Peter 2:1

Evil Speaking - Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, so that it will give grace to those who hear. Ephesians 4:29

Evil Speaking - If anyone thinks himself to be religious, and yet does not bridle his tongue but deceives his own heart, this man's religion is worthless. **James 1:26**

Fear - There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves punishment, and the one who fears is not perfected in love. **1 John 4:18**

Fear - For God has not given us a spirit of timidity [fear], but of power and love and discipline. 2 Timothy 1:7

Gluttony/Drunkenness - Do not be with heavy drinkers of wine, or with gluttonous eaters of meat; for the heavy drinker and the glutton will come to poverty, and drowsiness will clothe one with rags. **Proverbs 23:20-21**

Greed - Then He said to them, "Beware, and be on your guard against every form of greed; for not even when one has an abundance does his life consist of his possessions." **Luke 12:15**

Hatred - But the one who hates his brother is in the darkness and walks in the darkness, and does not know

where he is going because the darkness has blinded his eyes. 1 John 2:11

Hatred - If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for the one who does not love his brother whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen. 1 John 4:20

Homosexuality - ...Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals, nor thieves, nor the covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, will inherit the kingdom of God. **1 Corinthians 6:9-10**

Immorality (Sexual) - But immorality or any impurity or greed must not even be named among you, as is proper among saints; **Ephesians 5:3**

Ingratitude - Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father. Colossians 3:17

Judging - Do not judge so that you will not be judged. For in the way you judge, you will be judged; and by our standard of measure, it will be measured to you. **Matthew 7:1-2**

Laziness - Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might; for there is no activity or planning or knowledge or wisdom in Sheol [grave] where you are going. Ecclesiastes 9:10

Laziness - Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men, Colossians 3:23

Love of Money - But those who want to get rich fall into temptation and a snare and many foolish and harmful desires which plunge men into ruin and destruction. For the love of money is a root of all sorts of evil, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

1 Timothy 6:9-10

Lust - For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world. **1 John 2:16**

Lust - But each one is tempted when he is carried away and enticed by his own lust. Then when lust has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and when sin is accomplished, it brings forth death. **James 1:14-15**

Lying - Therefore, laying aside falsehood, SPEAK TRUTH EACH ONE of you WITH HIS NEIGHBOR, for we are members of one another. **Ephesians 4:25**

Pride - ...Clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, for GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE. Therefore, humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you at the proper time, **1 Peter 5:5-6**

Pride - A man's pride will bring him low, but a humble spirit will obtain honor. Proverbs 29:23

Stealing - He who steals must steal no longer; but rather he must labor, performing with his own hands what is good, so that he will have something to share with one who has need. **Ephesians 4:28**

Unforgiveness/Resentments - For if you forgive others for their transgressions, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive others, then your Father will not forgive your transgressions.
